Dear Ms. Ward:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 12, 2014. EGL requests an eighth extension of the STA granted on June 17, 2011, to operate Station WYRD with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits due to copper theft.¹ In support of the request, EGL requests an additional 90 days due to a delay in filing the required FCC Form 302 application due to flooding at the site.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WYRD may continue to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease

operation if complaints of interference are received. EGL must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² EGL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commissions exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. We anticipate that the FCC Form 302 application will be granted in the near future, therefore the 90 day request has been granted.

This authority expires on **March 8, 2015**.
