Dear Applicant:

This refers to the above-captioned application for KMWY(FM), Jackson, Wyoming.

KMWY(FM) was granted a construction permit (BNPED-19991214ACD) on May 30, 2007. The construction permit (condition #4) required the applicant to make proper radiofrequency electromagnetic (RF) field strength measurements throughout the transmitter site area to determine if there are any areas that exceed the FCC guidelines for human exposure to RF fields.


The applicant filed a license application (BLED-20100528AAB) to cover the construction permit (BNPED-19991214ACD). The applicant states that KMWY(FM) satisfies condition #4 because K216CI has terminated its operation and KMWY(FM) would not add any additional radiation to the site.

It can not be confirmed that K216CI has permanently stopped operating. K216CI has filed an extension of its Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to remain silent stating that K216CI is looking for a new site and a new frequency to begin operating.

In January 2011, the contact representative Mr. Southmayd contacted the FCC staff and stated "The tower owner in Jackson is not cooperating with us in getting RF measurements taken; we are not sure why. We are continuing to try and get the measurements." However, KMWY(FM) has not yet submitted any such measurements. Accordingly, we are providing KMWY(FM) with 30 days to submit this information.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to submit the requested RF measurement information. Failure to respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568. Please note, amendments must be filled in the same manner as the original application.
