Request for Extension of Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Oxenford:

This letter concerns the request you filed on March 18, 2015, on behalf of Sun Valley Radio, Inc. ("SVR"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to permit FM Translator Station K250AV to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that SVR stated that Station K250AV went silent on August 20, 2014, pending the proposed modification of its facilities. The previous STA was granted on October 8, 2014, and expired on April 6, 2015. SVR requests extension of its STA because modification of its facilities remains pending. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

SVR's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K250AV to remain silent until August 20, 2015. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K250AV will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., August 21, 2015.**<sup>1</sup>

SVR is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If SVR does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>2</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>3</sup>
