BACKGROUND

Applicant has filed an application for a new television translator on channel 17 in Winnemucca, NV.

Additional Interference Considerations

Application BNPTT20000831CGR, one of three applications in mutually exclusive group M353, was studied to identify outgoing or incoming interferences.

Mutually exclusive group M353 originally consisted of three applications:

NV 17 WINNEMUCCA	KTVU PARTNERSHIP	BNPTT20000831CGR
NV 17 WINNEMUCCA	SUNBELT COMMUNICATIONS/	BNPTTL20000829ALE
NV 32 IMLAY	HUMBOLDT COUNTY	BNPTT20000828AKC

These applications were considered mutually exclusive because of conflicts between the first and second and the second and third applications. There is no mutual exclusivity between the first and third applications. However, the Sunbelt Communications application BNPTTL20000829ALE has been dismissed, dissolving the group.

With the Sunbelt Communications application gone the first and third applications are "singletons".

The Longley-Rice OET Bul. 69 computer program used to analyze the above group also showed there is no outgoing or incoming interference either from or to any other license, construction permit or application.

Thus there is no interference conflict which would prevent the granting of application BNPTT20000831CGR.
