**MULTIPLE OWNERSHIP STUDY**

TECHNICAL STATEMENT  
RADIO MULTIPLE OWNERSHIP ANALYSIS  
CLEAR CHANNEL BROADCASTING LICENSES, INC.

This statement and the attached figures were prepared on behalf of Clear Channel Broadcasting Licenses, Inc., a licensee subsidiary of Clear Channel Communications, Inc. ("CCC"). CCC proposes the acquisition of KFXM(FM). A multiple ownership analysis was prepared considering the following radio stations under present or proposed common ownership or time brokerage:

KFXM(FM)	Temecula, CA	Channel 277A, 1.2 kW, 218 m
KFI(AM)	Los Angeles, CA	640 kHz, 50 kW, U, ND1

Under Section 73.3555(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules, "overlap between two stations in different services is permissible if neither of those two stations overlaps a third station in the same service." 47 C.F.R. §73.3555(a)(2).

The principal community coverage contour of KFXM(FM) do not overlap or intersect with any principal community coverage contour in the same service that is owned, brokered and/or are proposed to be owned by CCC, therefore, a common ownership study was not prepared.

For informational purposes Figure 1 herein shows the principal community coverage contours of KFXM(FM), KFI(AM) and KOGO(AM).

Based on the above, it is concluded that the proposed acquisitions comply with Section 73.3555(a) of the FCC Rules.
