

**REQUEST TO LOCATE MAIN STUDIO
OUTSIDE OF PRINCIPAL COMMUNITY CONTOUR**

Pursuant to Section 73.1125(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules, Christian Heritage Broadcasting, Inc. ("Christian Heritage") hereby requests permission to operate Station KBHZ, Willmar, Minnesota without a main studio within the station's principal community contour. In support of this request, the following is stated:

Christian Heritage is the licensee of Noncommercial Educational Stations KBHL(FM), Osakis, Minnesota and KBHZ(FM), Willmar, Minnesota. Christian Heritage proposes to operate KBHZ, which operates as a satellite of KBHL, without a main studio within the KBHZ's 3.16 mV/m contour. Its main studio will be located with the main studio of KBHL in Osakis, Minnesota – approximately 52 miles from Willmar.


Although Christian Heritage proposes to operate KBHZ without a main studio within the 3.16 mV/m contour, it will continue to have a significant presence in Willmar. It has developed a program designed to ensure that it will serve well the needs of Willmar's listeners. This program includes:

1. Advisory Committee. Christian Heritage will establish an advisory committee, composed of Willmar area residents, to meet at least on a quarterly basis with Christian Heritage management. Through this advisory committee, the station's Willmar Operations Manager and visits of the Christian Heritage staff to Willmar, Christian Heritage will ascertain the needs and interests of Willmar residents and ensure that KBHZ's programming meets those needs and interests.

2. Toll-Free Phone Number. Christian Heritage has established a toll-free telephone number for Willmar area listeners to call the KBHL studio in Osakis.
3. Local Public Inspection File. Christian Heritage will ensure that the public inspection file for KBHZ is maintained in Willmar.
4. Willmar News. As an Associated Press subscriber, Christian Heritage receives regular news reports regarding events and developments in Central Minnesota, thereby facilitating KBHZ's inclusion of significant Willmar area news in the station's five daily local news broadcasts.
5. Willmar School Closings. Willmar area school closings will continue to be broadcast over KBHZ.
6. Willmar Events on Community Calendar. At present, KBHZ airs a community calendar twelve times per day. Christian Heritage will ensure that Willmar area events continue to be included in the community calendar.
7. Willmar Area Weather Reports. KBHZ will provide comprehensive weather reports for the Willmar area.
8. Broadcast of Willmar Area Special Events. Christian Heritage staff members will visit the Willmar area and broadcast special events, such as local fairs and festivals, from that area.

With the measures described above, Christian Heritage is confident that it will continue to meet the needs and interests of Willmar residents with the programming broadcast over KBHZ.
