1. National Minority T.V., Inc. (“NMTV”) is seeking approval for a *pro forma* assignment of its licenses to the Trinity Christian Center of Santa Ana, Inc. (“Trinity”). NMTV’s directors, Dr. Paul F. Crouch, Sr., Mrs. Janice Crouch, and Paul Crouch, Jr., represent one hundred percent (100%) of the voting control of the organization (BTCCT - 20030326AAD; BOA - 20080313ABZ). Dr. & Mrs. Crouch, and Paul Crouch, Jr. also represent seventy-five percent (75%) of the voting control of Trinity (BTCCT - 20070613ACF) (three of four total directors).

2. In preparation for closing down its operations and dissolving, NMTV wishes to assign its Commission authorizations to Trinity. NMTV, which is one hundred percent (100%) controlled by seventy-five percent of Trinity’s voting control – three of Trinity’s four total directors represent all of NMTV’s voting control – is therefore submitting this *pro forma* assignment application (Form 316).¹ As explained in Instruction A.5. to Form 316, the short form is used in

“an assignment or transfer: (a) from a corporation to a wholly owned subsidiary thereof; (b) from a wholly owned subsidiary to the corporate parent; (c) from one wholly owed subsidiary to another; or (d) from one corporation to another corporation owned or controlled by the assignor’s/transferor’s stockholders in substantially similar proportions.”

¹ A *pro forma* assignment is also appropriate “where two parties have negative control (that is . . . exactly 50 percent of a licensee’s [voting control]).” *Canton 67, Ltd., Debtor-in-Possession*, 7 FCC Rcd 736, 70 RR 2d 788, ¶ 12 (1992) (case citations omitted); *Metromedia, Inc.*, 98 FCC 2d 300, 55 RR 2d 1278, ¶ 9 (1984) (transfers of negative control of 50% are “not substantial” and are handled with Form 316); *Transfer of Control of Certain Licensed Non-Stock Entities*, 4 FCC Rcd 3403, ¶¶ 23-29 (released April 11, 1989); *accord*, 47 CFR § 73.3540(f)(3). This is noted because Paul Crouch, Jr. was only added to the NMTV board within the last year, and his election to the NMTV board represents seventy-five percent (75%) of Trinity’s directors. Even without his election to the NMTV board, however, Dr. & Mrs. Crouch have held majority control of NMTV for several years (*see*, BTCCT - 20030326AAD; BOA - 20050729DKH), and they also represent fifty percent (50%) of the voting control of Trinity (BTCCT - 20070613ACF) (two of four total directors). Accordingly, based solely on Dr. & Mrs. Crouch’s position on Trinity’s board NMTV’s authorizations may be *pro forma* assigned to Trinity because fifty percent (50%) of Trinity’s directors (negative fifty percent control) already have majority control of NMTV. *Transfer of Control of Certain Licensed Non-Stock Entities*, 4 FCC Rcd 3403, FCC 89-90 (¶29(b)) (released April 11, 1989)(“insubstantial transfer of control . . . approval must be sought on an FCC Form 316 (short form) application”)

In this case, NMTV's authorizations may thus be *pro forma* assigned to Trinity because seventy-five percent (75%) of Trinity's directors (majority control) already have majority control of NMTV.

3. NMTV and Trinity are non-profit church corporations with self-perpetuating boards of directors. The directors of both organizations have had their qualifications approved in numerous long and short form assignment and transfer applications,² and in the renewal applications listed in paragraph 4, below.
