Dear Mr. Martinez:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 21, 2021. RVC requests a further extension of the STA granted on May 23, 2019, as last modified on December 3, 2020, to continue operating with the nighttime pattern during daytime hours, to allow time to complete repairs and file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.¹ In support of the request, we note that RVC will need additional time to complete all remaining repairs and file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RVC may continue to operate with the nighttime pattern during daytime hours, with reduced power if needed to maintain all monitor points within licensed limits, with no change to the licensed nighttime 50 kW six tower pattern operation. RVC must reduce power or cease operation during

¹ KCKN(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1020 kHz with 50 kW (day and night), using a three tower pattern daytime, and a six tower pattern at night.

daytime hours if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. RVC must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed to determine if any final STA operation with parameters at variance will be needed.

This authority expires on **December 9, 2021.**
