Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed September 13, 2012, on behalf of Kelly Broadcasting System Corporation ("KBS"). KBS requests further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on July 28, 2011, to operate Station WNIK-FM with reduced power.<sup>1</sup>

In support of the request, KBS states that the station's antenna system has been damaged by lightning, that repairing the damage will require replacement of major system components and that additional time is required to complete the repair work.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

<sup>1</sup> WNIK-FM is licensed for operation on Channel 293B1 (106.5 MHz) with effective radiated power of 25 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 6 meters. Construction Permit BPH-20111017ABN authorizes relocation of the transmitter and an increase in antenna height to 115 meters.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WNIK-FM may continue to operate with reduced power. KBS must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. KBS must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **May 1, 2013**.
