

Educational Qualifications and Programming

Inspiration Time, Inc. (“Inspiration Time”) is a nonprofit, nonstock corporation that was organized in 1965 in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The incorporated purposes of Inspiration Time include the writing, creating, producing and performance of religious, cultural and educational programs for radio broadcasting; and, in furtherance of such purposes, to acquire, equip, own, maintain and operate receiving, transmitting and broadcasting stations for the dissemination of news, reports, music, lectures and information.

Inspiration Time would apply its expertise gained as licensee of WCTL(FM), Union City, Pennsylvania, to the advancement of an educational program, in accordance with 47 C.F.R. Section 73.503, when tailoring programming for noncommercial educational station WTMV(FM), Youngsville, Pennsylvania, for which this assignment application is being submitted. Inspiration Time currently broadcasts on WCTL(FM) a mix of inspirational music and programs throughout the week, many of which are educational or informational in nature. “Focus On The Family” is representative of these types of educational programs. A half-hour in length, aired twice daily on weekdays, “Focus On The Family” typically addresses issues of concern to families and regularly includes interviews with everyday people, leaders in the religious and business communities and politicians. This program educates listeners on pending legislation and various public policy issues. Other educational programs which Inspiration Time produces and broadcasts are “Insight For Living” and “The Alternative.” These 30-minute programs are primarily religious education programs in which the hosts review and discuss Biblical texts, providing interpretation and insight. The 30-minute weekday show “Truths That Transform” serves to educate listeners about current trends and issues. Another educational program that Inspiration Time broadcasts is “Moments From American History” in which significant events in history are reviewed. A monthly segment, “Cooking on the Radio” features a chef offering recipes and cooking tips.

Live interviews with representatives from nonprofit organizations are featured by Inspiration Time on a regular basis. Examples of the types of organizations that Inspiration Time regularly partners with include the Warren County Christian School, the Community Blood Bank, The Women’s Care Center, The Salvation Army, The Mercy Center For Women, Hermitage House, The Girl Scouts of America, The YMCA, The Flagship Niagara League, Gifts For Kids, The American Cancer Society, area churches in Youngsville and Warren county, and many more. Inspiration Time also provides educational opportunities via internships and regular volunteer involvement, along with tours upon request and open houses twice a year. To support the public school system and community at large, Inspiration Time also provides award-winning coverage of high school football games in the fall, including those played by Warren High School, and encourages job-shadowing educational opportunities for area students.

Inspiration Time is aware that at present WTMV(FM) is silent. Should this application be granted and the authorization assigned, Inspiration Time is committed to promptly undertaking steps to resume operations of WTMV(FM). Programming aired on
