**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Oklahoma Community Television, LLC ("OCT"), permittee of low power television translator K42AG, Channel 42, Strong City, Oklahoma. OCT holds an outstanding permit to flash cut to digital operation on Channel 42 (BDFCDTT-20091229ACI). This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit for K42AG-D. Attached as Exhibit A is a calculation of the transmitter output power for the K42AG-D transmitter.

There is one special operating condition or restriction on the K42AG-D construction permit. The condition states that low power television is a secondary service and must not cause interference to existing or future full service television stations on NTSC or DTV channels and must accept interference from such stations. OCT accepts this condition.

Also, OCT will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of K42AG-D or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines. Based on the foregoing, it is believed K42AG-D is operating pursuant to the Commission's rules.
