

**Proposed LKCM Radio Group KJKB(FM)
Multiple Ownership Study**

The instant Multiple Ownership Study has been prepared to support the proposed assignment of radio Station KJKB(FM) from Hunt Broadcasting, Inc. to LKCM Radio Group, L.P (Applicant). Exhibit 13 reflects the stations in which LKCM Radio Group, L.P. has a cognizable interest.

KJKB(FM) is not located in an Arbitron rated market. The attached map shows the principal community contours of [70 dBu] of KJKB(FM), KFWR(FM), and KTFW-FM. As demonstrated on the map, there is no overlap of any portion of the KJKB contour with any other station in which the applicant has an interest, and as such, is in compliance with the requirements of 73.3555.

The Assignor will be filing shortly a FCC Form 301 seeking to change the reference coordinates of KJKB(FM). There will be no overlap between any broadcast station in which assignee currently holds an attributable interest and the 70 dBu contour of the KJKB(FM) modification facility requested in the Form 301.

The study is a true and accurate representation of the Applicant's compliance with the Ownership Rules to the best of the undersigned's knowledge and belief.
