



This is a certification that the WLOQ directional antenna authorized in construction permit BPH-20070416AAU was assembled and installed in accordance with the instructions provided by the manufacturer, Shively Labs.

I personally witnessed the field assembly and installation of this antenna between March 9<sup>th</sup> and March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2009. To the best of my knowledge and belief, the antenna was installed in full compliance with the included Shively Labs installation drawing 96832 revision – dated 12/22/08 for Shively Project 27107-A

The installation complies with all terms of the construction permit. The proper azimuth alignment of the tower and antenna was checked and verified as correct by Bill Joe Jenkins, Jr. a licensed Surveyor, as stated in Exhibit 27.

I presently hold an FCC General Radiotelephone Operator License (Number PG-17-22337) and have gained over thirty years of experience in the field of Engineering at various AM and FM radio stations. I am also an active member in the Society of Broadcast Engineers (4650), the National Society of Professional Engineers (101227613) and the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers (06540926).
