Dear Hossein:

On December 6, 2006, you sent us a letter, see Attachment A, informing Venture Technologies Group, LLC that your preliminary engineering review of our DCC application for Channel 50 Los Angeles (BDCCDTL-20061030ARW, Facility ID 167309) predicts to cause interference to KTRO-LP (BDFCDTL-20060809ALC, Facility ID 56793) on Channel 50, Lancaster, CA. This KTRO-LP flash cut application was filed on August 8, 2006.

The KNLA-LP DCC was originally applied for on a Form 175 on June 30, 2006 (BSFDTL-20060630AUY, Facility ID 167309). The KNLA-LP DCC was a singleton proposal, and in accordance with Public Notice DA 06-1748, released August 31, 2006, we applied for a Long Form 346 application on October 31, 2006 (BDCCDTL-20061030ARW).

Our DCC application was originally filed on Form 175 on June 30, 2006 and the KTRO-LP flash cut application was not filed until August 8, 2006; therefore, the KNLA-LP DCC application takes precedence over the later filed KTRO-LP flash cut application and the KTRO-LP flash cut application should be dismissed and the KNLA-LP DCC application should be immediately grantable.
