Dear Mr. Bradshaw:

I am writing to inform you of several important items relative to our permit.

Firstly, the Head of School at Sanford School, Mr. Mark Anderson, has informed me that they intend to withdraw their application or turn in their permit. When we spoke earlier this week, he promised to notify you of this decision in writing.


This will mean that we will not have to share radio time with them. Accordingly, I am requesting that their time be reallocated to us so that we will be able to broadcast 24 hours daily.

Secondly, the permit issued to us states that our license is "non-renewable". I am respectfully requesting that the "non-renewable" clause be deleted.

It would be important to approve both requests because of the potential impact on program planning and leasing a venue for a studio. The owners, managers of the prospective sites for the studio want to know whether the term of our tenancy will be twenty years or eight. We will be in a better negotiating position, if our license is renewable making it possible for us to enter into a long term lease.
