Dear Ms. Dortch:

Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna, Inc. (CCVE), the Licensee of offending FM translator station, K287BQ, Houston, TX continues to cause severe radio interference to our co-channel FULL-SERVICE FM Radio Station KTWL-FM 105.3, Todd Mission (Houston), TX.

KTWL-FM continues to receive written Complaints of Interference, in specific detail, from the listeners of KTWL and some more of these letters are attached. Please make these vital Letters of Complaint a part of the overall record involving filed FCC Complaint No. #1508554 against BOTH K287BQ and K231CN, Houston, TX. And to please add them to the many other well-documented Complaints of Interference Letters formally submitted to the Commission on file for nearly a year now.

KTWL and its loyal public listeners have most recently suffered severe loss of property and damage caused by Hurricane Harvey and these members of the public deserved the needed information KTWL-FM provided to these listeners and others before, during, and after this extremely dangerous and flooding hurricane. This illegal interference received by those affected KTWL-FM listeners was totally unnecessary and downright dangerous to them at a great time of need ... and this interference must be stopped, please! There are still hurricanes and tropical storms threatening here and throughout the south and eastern seaboard as I write this appeal to you, the Commission, today.

KTWL hereby formally continues to request and appeal to the authority of the Federal Communications Commission to ORDER the immediate cease of operations of K287BQ on our co-channel frequency of 105.3 (287) FM as it and KTWL cannot exist in the same market and KTWL has the legal right of protection from this interference as a FULL SERVICE licensed radio station.

We remind the Commission that K287BQ should have never been allowed to return to the air at all since the FCC Dallas Field Office, in an unannounced official FCC Inspection, found and labeled the alleged K287BQ a "Pirate Radio Station" and immediately ordered it SHUT DOWN. Further evidence found that Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna, the licensee of K287BQ and K231CN and other translator stations, had "misrepresented", lied, falsely documented official filings, and otherwise proved a "lack of candor" in its dealings DIRECTLY with the Federal Communications Commission. Additionally, Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna DENIED access to agents of the FCC Dallas Field Office in its Field Inspection of K231CN, against Commission authority and rule when FCC Agents observed that K231CN, Houston, TX was OPERATING IN GROSS EXCESS OF POWER AND WAS USING A NON-DIRECTIONAL, CIRCULARLY-POLARIZED MULT-BAY FM BROADCAST ANTENNA, instead of necessary highly directional, single polarization "Yagi" antennas to protect others from interference.... which results, to this day, gross interference to Co-Channel KLTR-FM, in Hempstead, TX, also located in the same Market of Houston, TX. Clear evidence, even today, shows that K231CN can be identifiably heard at the KLTR-FM transmitter facilities when KLTR-FM is powered off.


K231CN should be ordered off the air until this matter is properly inspected, reviewed, and corrected along with a determination that Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna is properly qualified to be a Licensee or otherwise properly sanctioned by the Federal Communications Commission for operating in dishonest, illegal, and cavalier acts towards this Commission.

I pray for immediate relief of interference from Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna stations K287BQ and K231CN. Both illegal and interfering translator stations.

KTWL-FM is in a dire situation and must be relieved of this open interference NOW, if it is to survive. It is nearly a year now. We never thought once that it would take so long to receive protection from the FCC, as mandated in its rules and by the United States Congress.

Please help now.
