Multiple Ownership

The common ownership of KCTY(AM), Salinas, California; KHMZ(FM), Salinas, California; KLOC(AM), Ceres, California; and KTGE(AM), Salinas, California (the “Trust I Stations”) by the Z-Spanish Trust (“Trust I”), Mark D. Inglis, Trustee, as well as the common ownership of KHNZ(FM), Soledad, California; KRAY-FM, Salinas, California; KSQR(AM), Sacramento, California; KZSA(FM), Placerville, California; KZSF(AM), San Jose, California; and KZSL(FM), King City, California (the “Trust II Stations”) by the Z-Spanish II Trust (“Trust II”), Mark D. Inglis, Trustee, complies with Section 73.3555(a) of the Commission’s multiple ownership rules.

The Commission previously approved the assignments of license of the Trust I Stations to Trust I (FCC File Nos. BAL-20000609AAX-Z and BALH-20000511AAY) and the assignments of the Trust II Stations to Trust II (FCC File Nos. BALH-20000814ABA-ABC, -ABE, -ABG and BAL-20000814ABD and -ABF) with Charles E. Giddens serving as the trustee of both Trusts. In addition, prior to the ownership of the Trust I and Trust II Stations by their respective Trusts, the Commission approved the common ownership of all 10 stations by Z-Spanish Media Licensing Company, LLC (FCC File No. BALH-19991206ACO). In the present applications, Trust I and Trust II will remain the licensees of their respective stations, and, because of the impending resignation of Mr. Giddens as the trustee of the Trusts referenced in Exhibit 5 hereto, only the trustee will change.

Because Mr. Inglis holds no additional attributable interests in the markets involving the present stations, prior Commission approval of the common ownership of these stations remains valid. Therefore, the transfer of control of Trust I and Trust II to Mr. Inglis would be in compliance with the Commission’s multiple ownership rules.
