Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed October 27, 2006, on behalf of Lakefront Communications, LLC ("LC"). LC requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on April 28, 2006, to operate Station WJYI with temporary facilities.¹

In support of the request, LC states that Station WFMR(FM) has filed an application to relocate to the WJYI tower, and that relocation of the FM station to the tower will delay restoration of licensed operation to Station WJYI.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due

to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WJYI may continue to operate with a long wire antenna. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. LC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² LC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **February 27, 2008**.
