Dear Mr. Wilkosz:

Letters announcing the intention of WSEE-TV/Erie to commence digital testing were mailed on July 23, 2007, to 156 medical facilities in its signal area.

Enclosed is a copy of the DTV Medical Notification, a list of the addresses, the Proof of Mailing stamped by the United States Post Office in Orlando, the counties used in the research and a map of the signal area.

In a subsequent package, you will receive the envelopes of the *non-deliverable letters* returned by the Post Office. The rate of return is about seven percent, and results when entities move and the forwarding period expires; because some refuse the letter, and because some facilities change their name. However, some that merged their ownership may have been notified under another name.

Whatever the reason for the returns, these envelopes along with the list of addressees and the letter receipts are evidence of your sincere attempt to inform the medical community. Please put all these documents relevant to the notification in your Public File.
