Dear Ms. Dortch:

Blue Chip Broadcasting Licenses LLC (Radio One) the licensee of station WJMO (AM) requests special temporary authority (STA) to operate WJMO at variance from its licensed parameters. WJMO uses four self-supporting towers in a licensed facility that produces a directional pattern used for unlimited time. One of the tower base insulators has developed a crack, and immediate replacement is necessary.

Licensee requests STA to operate WJMO with a non-directional radiation pattern at 1,250 watts, which is 25 percent of the licensed power of 5 KW (DA-1). STA term of 180 days requested in order to enable inspection and servicing of the other 15 base insulators in the array.

1. STA operation will enable continued broadcast service.
2. Immediate replacement is necessary to prevent collapse of the tower and extended operation at variance from the licensed parameters.
3. WJMO operated under STA recently during replacement of lighting equipment on the towers. During this STA operation, WJMO did not receive complaints of interference from the STA operation.
