Dear Mr. Oxenford:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 25, 2015. FBL requests a second extension of the STA granted on February 21, 2014 to operate station WNJC(AM) with emergency antenna facilities using tower #4 pursuant to Section 73.1680 due to vandalism.¹ In support of the request, FBL states that in the past six month STA period, all repairs were not yet completed due to the extreme winter conditions, but it plans to complete all repairs in the near future in order to resume licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED using **LESS**

¹ WNJC(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1360 kHz with 5 kW day and 0.8 kW night.

THAN 25% of licensed power (as previously granted), and not at 25% power as requested in this extension. Station WNJC(AM) may continue to operate using an emergency ND antenna and reduced power not to exceed 0.29 kW day and 0.043 kW night. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. FBL must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² FBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. We anticipate that FBL will file an FCC Form 302 application to update any operating parameters before the expiration date shown below.

This authority expires on **September 30, 2015**.
