

**Consent to Interference Proposed in DTV Construction Permit Modification
Application for WPXM-DT (Miami, Florida)**

Consistent with 47 C.F.R. §§ 73.623(g), (h)(3), Paxson West Palm Beach License, Inc., licensee of WPXP-DT (Lake Worth, Florida), hereby consents to WPXP-DT's receipt of interference created by the facilities proposed in the instant maximization application for WPXM-DT (Miami, Florida), licensed to Paxson Communications License Company, LLC. The parent company of both licensees is ION Media Network, Inc. ("ION").

The facilities proposed for WPXM-DT are predicted to cause interference in excess of that permitted under the Commission's rules to the currently authorized post-transition facilities for WPXP-DT. Because (i) both stations are owned by the same parent company and air programming provided by ION; (ii) all affected viewers would be able to receive over-the-air programming of one of the two stations; and (iii) maximization would allow WPXM-DT to reach viewers who heretofore could not receive its broadcast service, Paxson West Palm Beach License, Inc. believes this consent is in the public interest.

This consent applies only to the facilities explicitly proposed in the instant application. In no event shall this instant consent be deemed to apply to future modifications of WPXM-DT. Consistent with 47 C.F.R. §§ 73.623(g), (h)(3), the licensee of WPXM-DT must seek consent from the licensee of WPXP-DT to any further modification to WPXM-DT that increases the amount of predicted interference to WPXP-DT.
