

## Second Amendment

ION Media Networks, Inc. (“ION”), Scripps Media, Inc. (“Scripps”), and INYO Broadcast Holdings, LLC (“INYO”), hereby file this second amendment to pending applications seeking Commission consent to the transfer of control of certain licenses from ION to Scripps and the assignment of certain other licenses from ION to INYO. The purpose of the instant amendment is to certify that Scripps’ pending transaction to acquire KCDO-TV, Sterling, Colorado (FCC Facility ID Number 63158) in the Denver Designated Market Area (“DMA”) will not have an effect on the Commission’s review of Scripps’ proposed acquisition of certain ION stations.

As described in the pending application filed by Channel 3 TV Company, LLC and Scripps,<sup>1</sup> Scripps’ proposed acquisition of KCDO-TV complies with the Commission’s national and local television ownership rules. Scripps is the licensee of VHF station KMGH-TV, Denver, Colorado. Because Scripps already holds an interest in KMGH-TV in the Denver DMA, Scripps’ acquisition of UHF station KCDO-TV will not affect the calculation of Scripps’ national television holdings. In addition, Scripps’ proposed acquisition of KCDO-TV complies with the Commission’s local television ownership rule, because the Denver DMA will have more than eight independent voices should Scripps acquire KCDO-TV and KCDO-TV is not ranked among the top four stations in the Denver DMA.

Following completion of the Transaction, Scripps does not intend to own any television stations in the Denver DMA that are currently owned by ION. Accordingly, should Scripps consummate the transaction to acquire KCDO-TV, it will not affect Scripps’ proposed acquisition of the ION stations. Moreover, because INYO is acquiring ION’s KPXC-TV in the Denver DMA and INYO is a new entrant to the Denver DMA, the number of independent voices in the Denver DMA will not be reduced as result of the proposed transactions.
