

**Consent to Interference Proposed in DTV Construction Permit Modification  
Application for WPXG-DT (Concord, New Hampshire)**

Consistent with 47 C.F.R. §§ 73.623(g), (h)(3), Paxson Boston-68 License, Inc. ("Paxson Boston"), licensee of WBPX-DT (Boston, Massachusetts), hereby consents to WBPX-DT's receipt of interference created by the facilities proposed in the instant maximization application for WPXG-DT (Concord, New Hampshire), also licensed to Paxson Boston.

The facilities proposed for WPXG-DT are predicted to cause interference in excess of that permitted under the Commission's rules to the facilities proposed in Paxson Boston's maximization application for WBPX-DT. Paxson Boston has elsewhere consented to WPXG-DT's reciprocal receipt of interference created by the facilities proposed in its maximization application for WBPX-DT. The applications are in the public interest, and Paxson Boston is granting its consent, because maximizing both facilities will allow the stations to reach viewers who heretofore could not receive both stations' broadcast service.

This consent applies only to the facilities explicitly proposed in the instant application. In no event shall this instant consent be deemed to apply to future modifications of WPXG-DT. Consistent with 47 C.F.R. §§ 73.623(g), (h)(3), the licensee of WPXG-DT must seek consent from the licensee of WBPX-DT to any further modification to WPXG-DT that could increase the area of predicted interference to WBPX-DT.
