Dear Sirs:

The digital license for this channel has been granted but the channel is out of Core. That application was made as a first step for this translator to qualify as soon as possible for the funding recently made available through the NTIA Reimbursement Program.

We are making this application as a second step to move into Core. It is part of a complex master plan involving numerous other translators in northern Minnesota. One translator affects the next, and to be cost effective, they need to be grouped according to site. We have had Dr. Byron St. Clair run the channel numbers at their respective locations and they passed the TV Interference and Spacing Analysis Program. Also because of our proximity to Canada, some of these applications likely will need Canadian clearance. This digital flash cut was done, but the channel change into Core will not necessarily be done right away. We have been working with the new wireless licensees to comply with their needs to avoid interference until we get into Core.
