BRIDGE OF HOPE, INC. IS ORGANIZED FOR THE PURPOSE OF, 'THE CORPORATIONS ORGANIZED, AND SHALL BE OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR RELIGIOUS, CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES WITHIN THE MEANING OF SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, OR A RELATED SECTION OF THE SUCCESSOR STATUTE, (HEREINAFTER 'CODE'), INCLUDING, AMONG SUCH PURPOSES: ENGAGING THE BROADCAST, PRODUCTION, AND DISTRIBUTION OF RELIGIOUS, CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING AND OTHER MEDIA, AND SUCH OTHER RELIGIOUS, CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.'

THE BRIDGE OF HOPE, INC. EXISTS TO CONNECT AND STRENGTHEN THE LOCAL COMMUNITY. IT WILL PRODUCE RELIGIOUS AND EDUCATIONAL RADIO PROGRAMMING WITH A LOCAL FOCUS FOR THE DELMARVA PENINSULA COMMUNITY. WHILE WKNZ REACHES MOST OF THE DELMARVA PENINSULA WITH APPROXIMATELY 48,500 WEEKLY LISTENERS, THE VISION IS MUCH GREATER THAN JUST TERRESTRIAL FM RADIO AND INCLUDES A SMARTPHONE APP AND ONLINE LISTENING CAPABILITIES. THE NONCOMMERCIAL PROGRAMMING WILL EDUCATE THE COMMUNITY ON RELIGIOUS AND SOCIAL ISSUES BY PRODUCING AND BROADCASTING: (1) PROGRAMS OF A RELIGIOUS EDUCATIONAL NATURE, SUCH AS BIBLE TEACHING PROGRAMS; (2) PROGRAMS OF A GENERAL EDUCATIONAL AND PUBLIC AFFAIRS NATURE, AND (3) PROGRAMS FEATURING RELIGIOUS MUSIC. THE BRIDGE OF HOPE INC. WILL AIR PROGRAMMING WHICH WILL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS: DAILY BROADCASTS PERTAINING TO FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT INCLUDING BUDGETING; MARRIAGE AND RELATIONSHIP TRAINING; LOCAL NEWS & WEATHER INCLUDING ALERTS & CLOSINGS; PARENTING TIPS; SPOTLIGHT INTERVIEWS WITH LOCAL NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS TO HELP THEM ENGAGE OUR LISTENERS IN ADDRESSING LOCAL CONCERNS; MOVIE & VIDEO GAME REVIEWS FOR PARENTS TO HELP THEM MAKE WISE DECISIONS; AND THE STATION WILL ORGANIZE AND PROMOTE DAY-LONG SEMINARS WITH EXPERTS IN A VARIETY OF FIELDS INCLUDING MARRIAGE, WOMEN'S ISSUES, TEEN ISSUES, AND TRAINING FOR VOLUNTEERS WHO WISH TO HELP THE COMMUNITY.

THE BRIDGE OF HOPE, INC. WILL ALSO CONNECT ITS LISTENERS TO THE LARGER COMMUNITY BY MAINTAINING PRAYERWORKS, AN ONLINE CHURCH DIRECTORY, A JOB BOARD, AND CALENDARS OF CHRISTIAN SEMINARS AND CONFERENCES.
