Section 73.5005(a) Certification

The applicant certifies, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 73.5005(a), that the exhibits to this application contain all of the information required by 47 C.F.R. Agreements with Other Parties and Joint Bidding Arrangements

As indicated in the applicant's short-form application (FCC Form 175), the applicant did not enter into any bidding consortia, joint venture, partnership or other agreement or arrangement relating to the competitive bidding process.

Designated Entity Status

The applicant is eligible for a 25% new entrant bidding credit as it, or any individual or entity with an attributable interest in it, has had an attributable interest in no more than three media of mass communications, as defined in 47 C.F.R. § 73.5008,¹ since the short-form application filing deadline (August 12, 2005). Specifically, since that deadline, the applicant and the parties to the application have had and continue to have an attributable interest in the FM broadcast station, WEYE(FM), Surgoinsville, TN, and the applicant and the parties to the application did not and continue to not have an attributable interest in any other mass media facilities. As indicated in the applicant's short-form application, WEYE(FM) does not serve the "same area" as the facilities proposed herein pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.5007.

¹ Under 47 C.F.R. § 73.5008(b), a medium of mass communications means a daily newspaper; a cable television system; or a license or construction permit for a television broadcast station, an AM or FM broadcast station, a direct broadcast satellite transponder, or a Multipoint Distribution Service station.
