ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

(Under Chapter 1702 of the Ohio Revised Code)
Non-Profit Corporation

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under Sections 1702.01 et seq. of the Ohio Revised Code, do hereby state the following:

FIRST. The name of said corporation shall be Central Ohio Green
Education Fund

SECOND. The place in Ohio where its principal office is to be located is 1066 N. High St.
Columbus, Ohio 43201-2440, Franklin County, Ohio
(city, village or township)

THIRD. The purpose(s) for which this corporation is formed is:

The purposes and objectives of the Fund shall be to:

1. conduct and promote educational, charitable and scientific activities, working within the context of ten key values: ecological wisdom, grassroots democracy, social justice, non-violence, decentralization, community-based economics, feminism, respect for diversity, personal and global responsibility, and future/sustainability;
2. conduct and promote bioregionally-based educational programs and research to disseminate the knowledge gained from implementing these values;
3. Carry out other activities as may be necessary and proper to accomplish the foregoing objectives and purposes.

4. Have all necessary and incidental powers to carry on its purposes; together with the right and power to hold property, both real and personal, of every nature and description whatsoever, whether the same be received by bequest, devise, gift, or grant, or in trust, or otherwise, or whether the same be held conditionally or generally together with the power to sell, assign, mortgage, pledge, or dispose of in any manner, any property which it owns or has any rights to.

In general, to have all the powers conferred upon corporations and associations not for profit, and such additional powers as may be conferred upon such organizations in the future, under the laws of the State of Ohio.

ARTICLE IV.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE V.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing of or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VI.

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

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FOURTH. The following persons, not less than three, shall serve said corporation as trustees until the first annual meeting or other meeting called to elect trustees.
