Dear Mr. Barton:

A review of the Commission's records reveals that station WFOL-LP, Ft. Pierce, Florida, has been silent since before September 5, 2004.¹

Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, provides in pertinent part that if a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license shall expire at the end of that period.²

Accordingly, the license for station WFOL-LP IS FORFEITED, and the call sign IS HEREBY DELETED. Moreover, in view of this action, the above-captioned pending application for Special Temporary Authority is moot, and IS HEREBY DIMISSED.
