

## COMPLIANCE WITH MULTIPLE OWNERSHIP RULES

By this application (the “Application”), Citadel Broadcasting Company (“Citadel”) proposes to re-acquire radio broadcast station WMGL(FM), Facility ID No. 61592, Ravenel, South Carolina (the “Station”), from The Last Bastion Station Trust, LLC, as Trustee.

The Station’s community of license is Ravenel, which is located in Charleston County, South Carolina. Charleston County is included in the Charleston, South Carolina Arbitron Metro.

The attached Exhibit, *FCC Geographic Market Definition for Charleston, SC*, was compiled on December 13, 2007 using BIA Research, Inc.’s *Media Access Pro* database. The Exhibit lists all radio stations, including the Station, that are listed as “home” to the Charleston Arbitron market, or that have a community of license located within the counties comprising the Charleston Arbitron market, even if such stations list another Arbitron market as “home.”

As demonstrated in the Exhibit, there are 32 stations in the Charleston Arbitron market. Pursuant to the local radio ownership rules, 47 C.F.R. § 73.3555(a)(1), a person or single entity (or entities under common control) in a radio market with between 30 and 44 (inclusive) full-power, commercial and noncommercial radio stations may have a cognizable interest in not more than 7 commercial radio stations in total, and not more than 4 commercial stations in the same service (AM or FM).

Upon a grant of the Application and the consummation of the transactions proposed therein, Citadel would own 5 stations in the Charleston market (4 FM and 1 AM): WSSX-FM, WIWF(FM), WWWZ(FM), WMGL(FM) and WTMA(AM). Therefore, the transaction proposed by the Application would comply with the local radio ownership rules set forth at 47 C.F.R. § 73.3555.
