RE: IBOC power level for WWRZ, Fort Meade, Florida

WWRZ in Fort Meade, Florida raised its IBOC power level to -14dBc on May 2, 2011. We sent proper notice on May 9, 2011. However, a check of the FCC database today, does not show any evidence that the notice had been received and processed. Therefore we are resubmitting this notification.

We also hereby again certify that except for the new increased power level, the IBOC facility conforms to the Ibiqity specifications as required. WWRZ operates with separate analog and digital transmitters from an ERI DI-4A, dual input antenna. WWRZ operates with an ERP of 27 KW analog and 1.075 KW digital.
