Family of God Fellowship Church, Inc. ("Family"), applicant for the above-referenced new Low Power FM Station at Topeka, Kansas, herein updates its previous reports, filed June 30, July 30 and August 28, 2014, with respect to the progress that has been made in demonstrating that Family's proposed LPFM facilities comply with the Nationwide Programmatic Agreement and Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.

As previously reported, Family is working with Dynamic Environmental Associates, Inc. ("DEAI"). As also previously reported, the Kansas State Historic Preservation Office ("SHPO") issued a letter dated August 21, 2014 indicating the proposed antenna structure would have no adverse effect on the subject property.

Family, working with DEAI, now needs to obtain Tribal clearance for the project. Sixteen Tribes have expressed an interest in the project location; thus far ten of those Tribes have cleared the project. Family is hopeful that the Tribal consultation process will be completed within the next 30 days.
