

Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authorization

Radio License Holding CBC, LLC (“RLH”), pursuant to Section 73.1635 of the FCC’s rules, hereby requests that the initial special temporary authorization (“STA”) for radio station KNEV(FM), Reno, Nevada (Facility ID 11244) (File No. BSTA-20151207AMM), be extended for an additional 180 days.

Station KNEV is licensed to operate on Channel 238 with 60 kW effective radiated power at 695 meters height above average terrain. Prior to the filing of its STA request, RLH informed the Commission that the station’s transmitter had malfunctioned and that KNEV was operating with reduced power due to transmitter failure. RLH initially believed that KNEV’s transmitter could be repaired. RLH subsequently determined, however, that the transmitter would need to be replaced. RLH currently is in the process of seeking corporate approval to order a new replacement transmitter and anticipates that a new transmitter should be available by the early Fall.

For the reasons stated herein, RLH respectfully requests a further extension of the existing STA for a period of 180 days pursuant to Section 73.1635 of the Commission’s rules to operate KNEV at approximately 80 percent (80%) of its licensed power until the new transmitter arrives. The requested extension will serve the public interest because it will enable the station to continue to serve the residents of Reno and the surrounding area until RLH can return the station to full licensed power.
