Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed June 3, 2014, on behalf of Lighthouse Radio Group ("Lighthouse"). Lighthouse explains that the transmission line of KYSJ burned up, and that the station resumed operation with an exciter unit fed into a yagi antenna mounted at about the 50 foot level on the licensed tower structure. Lighthouse requests an STA to continue such operation while the transmission system is being rebuilt.

Section 73.1680 of the Commission's rules provides for operation with emergency antenna facilities following damage to authorized antenna systems, provided that an informal request for continued use of an emergency antenna is filed with the Commission within 24 hours. In particular, Section 73.1680(b)(2) provides that FM and TV stations may erect any suitable radiator, or use operable sections of the authorized antenna(s) as an emergency antenna.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KYSJ may continue to operate with the emergency facilities it erected at the licensed tower site. Lighthouse must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. Lighthouse must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **December 2, 2014**.
