

**DESCRIPTION OF TRANSACTION;  
RESPONSE TO ITEM 17**

By this minor change application, Christian Voice of Central Ohio, Inc. ("Voice"), licensee of WCVZ-FM, hereby requests a change in its license status from non-commercial to commercial status. Although Voice is, and will continue to be, a non-profit Section 501(c)(3) charitable organization, Voice has decided that it is better off operating WCVZ as a commercial FM broadcast station, able to sell advertising, thereby producing a revenue stream that can be used to fund Voice's various charitable activities. Because WCVZ is licensed in the non-reserved FM band, on channel 224 (92.7 MHz), this application is a permissible minor change. *See, e.g., Reexamination of the Comparative Standards for Noncommercial Educational Applicants*, 15 FCC Rcd. 7386, 7431 (2000); *WNYC Communications Group*, 11 FCC Rcd. 13841, 13843 (Mass Media Bur., 1996).

There is no change whatsoever in the ownership or control of the station, or in the station's technical parameters.

Voice also holds two translator stations that rebroadcast the programming of station WCVZ, *viz.* W233AK and W300AQ. Only W300AQ extends the service area coverage of WCVZ. (*See* attached contour map of WCVZ and W233AK.)

Voice realizes that upon the station becoming a commercial station, continued ownership and control of translator station W300AQ by Voice would be contrary to Commission Rules. Therefore, Voice agrees that the grant of this minor change application may be conditioned upon Voice, within thirty days of the grant of this application, either: (a) returning the license for station W300AQ for cancellation; or (b) filing an application for assignment of station W300AQ to an unaffiliated entity. Voice already has offered to assign station W300AQ to a non-commercial entity located in Williamstown, WV (that station's community of license) at no charge, and is waiting for a reply to that offer.
