

**DESCRIPTION OF THE TRANSACTION**

By this application, authority is sought for the transfer of control of Fisher Broadcasting - Georgia, L.L.C., licensee of WFXG(TV), Augusta, Georgia and WXTX(TV), Columbus, Georgia. Currently, the sole member, asset holder, and manager of Fisher Broadcasting - Georgia, L.L.C. is Fisher Broadcasting Company, and the manager of the licensee is William W. Krippaehne, Jr. The licensee has no officers.

Following the transfer of control sought herein, Fisher Broadcasting Company will remain the sole member, asset holder, and manager of Fisher Broadcasting - Georgia, L.L.C. However, Fisher Broadcasting Company will replace William W. Krippaehne, Jr. as Fisher Broadcasting - Georgia, L.L.C.'s manager, and the following individuals will become officers of Fisher Broadcasting - Georgia, L.L.C:

No other changes will take place. Fisher Broadcasting Company will continue to have the same ownership, officers, and directors that were disclosed in its last biennial ownership report filed on September 28, 2001.

Fisher Broadcasting Company is a Delaware corporation, and all of its officers and directors are United States citizens. Fisher Broadcasting - Georgia, L.L.C. is a Delaware limited liability company, and all of its officers are United States citizens.

The replacement of the current manager of Fisher Broadcasting - Georgia, L.L.C. with its existing sole member and the appointment of officers to the company constitute internal reorganizations without any substantial change in beneficial ownership or control and will take place without any written agreements or payment of consideration.
