Dear Mr. Gonzalez:

This is in reference to the request filed on December 3, 2021. RVC requests a further extension of the STA granted on May 23, 2019, as last modified, to continue operating with the nighttime pattern with reduced power (day and night), to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, RVC stated that additional time will be needed to complete all remaining repairs to the three tower daytime pattern (and file the application).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RVC may continue to operate with the licensed six tower nighttime pattern during daytime hours with a reduced power of 30 kW, and with the same licensed nighttime pattern during the night with a maximum of 50 kW. RVC must reduce the daytime power level or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. RVC must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed to allow our staff to determine if any further temporary

operation is required.

This authority expires on **June 20, 2022**.
