Pursuant to Section 73.3544(c) of the Commission's rules, this letter hereby notifies the Commission that KQED Inc., the licensee of three noncommercial educational television stations, two noncommercial FM radio stations, two FM translator stations, one FM booster station, and numerous broadcast auxiliary stations, changed its name from Northern California Public Broadcasting, Inc. to KQED Inc. on December 21, 2010. This name change does not involve a change of the ownership or control of the stations and, accordingly, may be accomplished by written notification to the Commission. 47 C.F.R. §73.3544(c). Notification of the name change was provided in all of the FCC electronic databases in or before June 2011. However, a letter was not filed with the Secretary's office at that time. At the request of the Media Bureau staff, a written notification is being filed with the Secretary's office.


