Request for Extension of Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Ms. O'Connor:

This letter concerns the request you filed on October 13, 2017, on behalf of Educational Media Foundation (EMF), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit FM Radio Station KAIH to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that EMF stated that Station KAIH(FM) went silent on March 27, 2017, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on April 21, 2017, and expired on October 18, 2017. EMF requests extension of its STA, pending the proposed modification of its facilities. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

EMF's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KAIH(FM) to remain silent until March 27, 2018. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KAIH(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., March 28, 2018.**<sup>1</sup>

EMF is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If EMF does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>2</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>3</sup>
