¹ - On December 2, 2013, REC had filed an *Informal Objection* against 246 LPFM applicants that showed evidence of an alleged connection with Antonio Cesar Guel, the president of Hispanic Christian Community Network (HCCN), licensee of KSFV-LD and KHFW-LD, Dallas TX as well as dozens of LPTV stations nationwide. In our *Informal Objection*, we challenged the existence of these organizations within their local communities as well as other legal issues with the applications.

² - Our withdrawal covers only this specific LPFM application and does not diminish our concerns about the other LPFM applications from the original *Informal Objection* and subsequent January 12, 2015 *Informal Objection* except those that were the subject of previous subsequent withdrawals by REC.
