

Educational Objective and Program

Strong Tower Christian Media, ("Transferee") is a non-stock, non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Ohio and will be qualified as a tax exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Transferee certifies that it will operate the radio station in full compliance with Section 73.503 of the FCC's Rules. The Transferee's board of trustees is dedicated to nurturing and continuing high quality non-commercial educational radio. The Transferee seeks, through education, to foster greater knowledge and understanding of the Bible, to teaching principles of Christian living, and to promote moral, ethical and beneficial actions and relationships.

As a religious and educational organization, the Transferee's educational program involves the following goals: provide regular educational programming designed to teach the Bible using scriptural models and lessons and will dedicate a substantial amount of time to Bible teaching programs. Programs will include teaching programs produced by other quality non-commercial sources and from its own productions. All programming will be broadcast commercial-free. The Transferee may also broadcast live teaching, devotion, worship and daily prayer services from its church fellowship.

The Transferee will continue the licensee's established educational program practices designed to educate the public with accurate and practical information concerning such issues as religion, child rearing, physical and mental health, citizenship, government, pregnancy out of wedlock, restoring respect to family and community, ethics, vocational opportunities, drug abuse, the benefits of continuing general education, social concerns, mental health and urban issues. Teaching methods in support of its programming goals include Bible, study, religious news and viewpoints, interactive discussions, devotionals, religious services, sermons, contemporary and historical and contemporary sacred music, scientific information, government studies, secular news and public affairs, and public service announcements. Many programs will be hosted by nationally known Bible teachers and scholars. The ongoing needs of the radio station's listening audience will be regularly reviewed and existing educational programming will be adjusted as appropriate to meet those needs.

The station will provide a regular forum for listeners to participate in dialogue concerning issues of importance. The station will provide uplifting music on a commercial-free basis, and a forum for discussion directed to the unique needs of the local community. Bringing this discussion to listeners who might otherwise not attend religious educational functions engages listeners to think seriously on the Gospel, morality, religion, culture, history, relationships, and helping others.

The station will provide news and weather information throughout the day. In short, the Transferee intends to uphold and further the licensee's well-developed educational policies and practices designed to serve as a valuable educational resource which will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.
