Notification of Silent Status and Request for Special Temporary Authority

FM Translator Station K220AV, Taos, NM (Facility ID 55567)

The Regents of the University of New Mexico (“UNM”), pursuant to Section 74.1263 of the Commission’s rules, hereby notifies the FCC of the temporary suspension of operations of FM translator Station K220AV, Taos, New Mexico. In addition, UNM respectfully requests Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) for a period of six (6) months in order to maintain the silent status of K220AV for more than thirty (30) days.

UNM will temporary suspend operation of Station K220AV on September 27, 2012. UNM is suspending service over K220AV due to the impact on its operation of modifications to UNM’s co-licensed full service station KRRT(FM) in the Taos area, and due to the accessibility of the translator station’s facility site. UNM is now exploring its options for K220AV’s resumption of operation following modification or relocation, a change in program source, and/or transfer. A grant of STA will serve the public interest by authorizing the FM translator station’s temporary off-air status while UNM works towards a long-term plan for restoring broadcast service for this station.

UNM is a noncommercial educational broadcaster and operates Station K220AV on a noncommercial educational basis. Moreover, UNM qualifies as a governmental entity. The licensee is therefore exempt from filing fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1116 of the Commission’s rules and exempt from regulatory fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Commission’s rules.
