

Dear Ms. Dortch:

LIN of New Mexico, LLC is filing the accompanying application for an STA to operate television translator station K40GC, Dora, New Mexico, on channel 69. In addition to providing television service to the Dora area, this translator also provides a signal to another LIN translator, K49BY, which serves Clovis, New Mexico.

Another translator in Clovis, K41JI, recently began to operate on channel 41, and now prevents reception at K49BY of the channel 40 signal from Dora. LIN has received numerous complaints from listeners who have lost access to LIN's programming. The use of channel 69, for which K40GC was previously licensed, will enable service in Clovis to be restored, pending the development of a long-term solution. Prompt approval of this application will minimize the disruption of service in Clovis.
