This letter refers to the above-referenced application filed by Lehigh Valley Community Broadcasters (“Licensee”) for renewal of its license for Station WDIY(FM), Allentown, Pennsylvania. We are in receipt of a Petition for Reconsideration (“Petition”) of the grant of the Application filed by Andrew Rumbold on August 15, 2014.<sup>1</sup> The Petition, filed by mail with Commission, indicates that it was served on you by fax. No response has been received. We are hereby serving you an additional copy of the Petition.

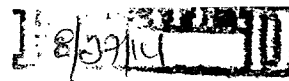

I am asking the FCC to reconsider the license renewal application noted above. The attached letter I sent to my Senator and State Representative on June 13, 2014 details the issue. The office of Rep Mike Fitzpatrick suggested I file this petition for reconsideration.

In short, I was refused access to the stations FCC logbook during regular business hours in violation of FCC rules. I was unable to make it to the appointment time to view the book and to this date have not received access to it. My questions about equal time for a public funded radio program have also gone unanswered. I have also filed an informal complaint through the FCC website with confirmation number 14-C00602424 on July 31, 2014 and have not yet received a response.

Dear Senator Toomey,

WDIY radio operating out of Bethlehem PA is public funded radio and in the most recent available IRS filing on their website (IRS form 990 -2011) it was disclosed that they received \$117,838 in government grants for that fiscal year.

On May 29<sup>th</sup> at from 6-7 pm their regular program "Lehigh Valley Discourse" featured what can best be described as an hour of propaganda for gun control and violating the rights of Americans. There was only emotional argument in favor of further restriction on guaranteed rights of Americans to keep and bear arms, and no counterpoint and no calls taken to allow for the other side of the debate to be heard.

On behalf of Concerned Gun Owners of Pennsylvania and Firearms Owners Against Crime- I left a voicemail the following day for Wagner Previanto who is the executive director of WDIY requesting a call back- this call was never returned. I followed up on June 3<sup>rd</sup> with an email to Mr Previanto and copied to WDIY operations director Neil Hever to emphasize our request for an hour show to present the fact based side of the gun control debate. This email was replied to the following day by Mr Hever that Mr Previanto was aware of our request.

I finally got a response from Mr Previanto on June 6 indicating " WDIY will air another segment of the show giving the opportunity for people of a different opinion to share their thoughts. I will send you the show schedule when its available.". I replied later that day requesting that a representative from our organizations be invited to participate and asked for details and a timeframe. This email was never replied to.

Today June 13 at approximately 10am I visited WDIY offices in person and was received by Mr Wagner. I requested access to their FCC file book and to register a complaint. I asked and was denied access several times, and requested by Mr Previanto to make an appointment which I did for July 1. This is in direct violation of FCC rule under CFR 47.3526(c) as follows: (c) Access to material in the file. (1) The file shall be available for public inspection at any time during regular business hours.

As my representative in the US Senate I am requesting your intervention in this matter to facilitate the request of our groups to be given airtime for an opposing viewpoint on this political issue. I would like to know what action you will take and which departments you will involve regarding the clear violation of law by way of Mr Previanto's refusal to allow me access to their FCC file book.
