Dear Mr. Butler:

We have purchased the equipment and are ready to construct our station in accordance with our construction permit referenced above.

The tower on which we propose to mount our antenna is an existing, 35 foot, VHF communications tower constructed in 1973 when our building was built. Between our tower and the WLMC tower is a 150-foot water tower, also owned by the City of Georgetown. The water tower itself is 100 feet from the existing tower on which we propose the WGEO antenna.

Based on this, we feel our original engineering company did not provide adequate information to the Commission regarding our tower and respectfully request your consideration to suspend the requirements outlined in item 2 of Special Operating Conditions or Restrictions of the construction permit.
