Informal Objection

Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration: (1) the above captioned application; (2) the Informal Objection filed by Capstar TX LLC (“Capstar”) on March 20, 2013; (3) all related pleadings. For the reasons set forth herein, we grant the Informal Objection and dismiss the application BPFT-20130219ACO.

Capstar, licensee of KCCY-FM, Pueblo, Colorado, filed an Informal Objection that the proposed application will cause interference to listeners of KCCY-FM. Capstar states that this proposed facility is in violation of Section 74.1204(f). In order to provide convincing evidence under Section 74.1204(f) that grant of the translator construction permit “will result in interference to the reception” of an existing full-service station, an opponent must provide, at a minimum: (1) the name and specific address of each listener for which it claims credit; (2) some demonstration that the address of each purported listener falls within the 60 dB μ contour of the proposed translator station;¹ (3) some evidence, such as a declaration from each of the claimed listeners, that the person listens to the full-service station at the specified location; and (4) evidence that grant of the authorization will result in interference to the reception of the “desired” station at that location. The “undesired-to-desired” (“U/D”) signal strength ratio methodology may be used to demonstrate the potential for interference under Section 74.1204(f).² Section 74.1204(f) requires the objector to show that a specific U/D signal strength ratio is exceeded at the location of a *bona fide* listener of the desired station to establish that interference will result.



The petitioner submitted documentation from thirteen listeners that certified and they are listeners of KCCY-FM and live, work or travel within the 60 dBu contour of proposed translator. Since the Petitioner has demonstrated that thirteen listeners are within the proposed 60 dBu contour of proposed application for K245AD, the application is dismissed.

Accordingly, the Informal Objection filed on March 20, 2013 by Capstar IS HEREBY GRANTED, the application BPFT-20130219ACO IS HEREBY DISMISSED. These actions is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.

INFORMAL OBJECTION

Capstar TX LLC (“Capstar”), licensee of KCCY-FM, Channel 245 (96.9MHz), Pueblo, Colorado, FCC Facility ID No. 40847 (“KCCY-FM”), by its attorney, hereby submits this Informal Objection pursuant to Sections 73.3587 and 74.1204(f) of the Commission’s Rules to the application (the “Modification Application”) of Mainstreet Media of Colorado, LLC (“Mainstreet”) for a construction permit for the minor modification of FM translator K245AD, Channel 245 (96.9MHz), Arvada, Colorado, FCC Facility ID No. 140240 (the “Translator”). 1/

At Attachment A are the declarations of thirteen regular listeners of KCCY-FM who regularly listen to KCCY-FM from locations within the predicted 1 mV/m (60 dBu) contour of the Translator as proposed in the Modification Application. 2/ See Engineering Exhibit at

1/ In order to qualify as a “minor modification” the Modification Application must be granted a “Mattoon Waiver,” which is requested at Exhibit 12 thereto. Capstar takes no position as to whether the Modification Application qualifies for such a waiver.

2/ Each of these listeners confirms in their statement that they are not affiliated with KCCY-FM.

Attachment B. The Engineering Exhibit also establishes that grant of the Modification Application would result in predicted interference to the reception of the co-channel KCCY-FM signal to these listeners.

Section 74.1204(f) of the Commission's Rules provides:

An application for an FM translator station will not be accepted for filing even though the proposed operation would not involve overlap of field strength contours with any other station, as set forth in paragraph (a) of this section, if the predicted 1 mV/m field strength contour of the FM translator station will overlap a populated area already receiving a regularly used, off-the-air signal of any authorized co-channel, first, second or third adjacent channel broadcast station, including Class D (secondary) noncommercial educational FM stations and grant of the authorization will result in interference to the reception of such signal.

Thus, whether or not the showing in the Modification Application of no overlap of the Translator's interfering contour with KCCY-FM's protected contour is sustainable, the Modification Application must be dismissed or denied pursuant to Section 74.1204(f) due to predicted interference to the reception of the regularly-used signal of KCCY-FM within the predicted 1 mV/m field strength contour of the Translator as proposed in the Modification Application.

This statement documents that station KCCY-FM, Pueblo, Colorado, FCC Facility ID No. 40847, has a regularly used, off-the-air signal, within the predicted 1 mV/m (60 dBu) contour of FM Translator K245AD as proposed to be modified in FCC File No. BPFT-20130219ACO, and that listeners to this signal will receive interference to that reception.

Section 74.1204(f) of the Commission Rules states:

An application for an FM translator station will not be accepted for filing even though the proposed operation would not involve overlap of field strength contours with any other station, as set forth in paragraph (a) of this section, if the predicted 1 mV/m field strength contour of the FM translator station will overlap a populated area already receiving a regularly used, off-the-air signal of any authorized co-channel, first, second or third adjacent channel broadcast station, including Class D (secondary) noncommercial educational FM stations and grant of the authorization will result in interference to the reception of such signal.





Figure 2. Table of Listener Data

Attached as Figure 1 is a contour map plotting the KCCY-FM 52 dBu and 55 dBu F:50:50 signal contours and the 60 dbu F50:50 (1 mV/m) contour proposed by File No. BPFT-20130219ACO. In Figure 2, a table of listening locations representing known, documented listeners of KCCY-FM who regularly receive the off-the-air signal of KCCY-FM is presented. Signed statements by these listeners are a part of this opposition.

The various contours were transferred to a Google Earth presentation of the geographic coordinates of listening locations given in Figure 2. As can be seen, all of this group of regular users of the off-the-air signal of KCCY-FM are predicted to receive a KCCY-FM signal of between 52 and 55 dBu and each listening location is located within the 60 dBu (1 mV/m) contour proposed by File No. BPFT-20130219ACO. Pursuant to Section 74.1204(a)(3) of the Commission's Rules a signal any greater than 20 dB lower than the desired signal will cause interference. In this instance, these identified listeners of KCCY-FM would be subjected to an interfering signal at least 5 dB *greater* in strength than the KCCY-FM signal from the facilities proposed by File No. BPFT-20130219ACO, clearly establishing predicted interference under the 20 dBu standard. Thus each of these documented listeners who regularly receive the off-the-air signal of KCCY-FM would have that reception interfered with if File No. BPFT-20130219ACO were granted and implemented.

Figure 1. Contour Map, 60 dBu of Translator, 52 dBu and 55 dBu of KCCY-FM


Figure 3. Signal contours with Listener Locations
