TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Real Media, Inc. ("RMI"), licensee of radio station WNNT-FM, Channel 265A, Warsaw, Virginia. RMI has an outstanding permit to make minor changes in the facilities of WNNT-FM (BPH-20061129AKX). RMI herein submits a license application to cover the outstanding permit. A calculation of the transmitter power output of the WNNT-FM transmitter is attached as Exhibit A.

There are three operating conditions/restrictions on the WNNT-FM permit. The first condition states that RMI will reduce the power of WNNT-FM, or cease operation as needed, to insure that persons with access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency radiation levels in excess of the Commission's guidelines. RMI will comply with this requirement.

The second condition states that program tests for WNNT-FM will not commence on Channel 298A until program tests for WKHI, Fruitland, Maryland commence on Channel 299. Furthermore, a license will not be granted to WNNT-FM on Channel 298 until a license is granted to WKHI in Channel 299. WKHI is operational on Channel 299A. Further, a license was granted for WKHI on Channel 299¹ on October 17, 2008. Therefore, RMI is submitting this instant license application for WNNT-FM on Channel 298.

The third condition states that the grant of construction permit BPH-20061129-AKX is conditioned on the final outcome of MB Docket 04-409. The final outcome of the proceeding may require WNNT-FM to change frequency, class, site location or dismantle the facilities authorized herein. Accordingly, any change made pursuant to the permit is at the sole risk of the permittee. A license to cover this permit will not be granted until MB Docket 04-409 is final. RMI acknowledges this condition.

Based on the foregoing, it is believed that WNNT-FM is operating in compliance with the Commission's rules and that all conditions have been met.
