Ladies and Gentlemen:

Franklin County Translator District understands that KCVB-LD is applying for an ERP increase on their channel 26 station in Logan, UT. Also, we know the Longley-Rice Terrain Dependent Interference studies indicate the potential for some interference to our stations, K25HG-D and K27GM-D. Their file numbers are as follows: BLDTT20090107AGB and BLDTT20090107AGF, respectively.

Further, we understand the Longley-Rice Interference studies tend to be conservative and the interference indicated may not occur in practice. Since the interference is predominately in the Logan, UT area and is not interfering with our service areas in the northern part of Utah and the southern areas of Idaho, Franklin County Translator District doesn't believe its translator system will have a problem with the ERP increase of KCVB-LD. Further, Cache Valley Broadcasting, Inc., the owner of KCVB-LD, will cooperate with us to resolve any interference issues which may occur in practice.

Consequently, Franklin County Translator District has "No Objection" to the grant of Cache Valley Broadcasting's application for an ERP increase for KCVB-LD provided the construction permit is issued with the requirement to use a stringent mask.
