TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and exhibits were prepared on behalf of Vandalia Media Partners, LLC ("Vandalia"), licensee of FM translator station W294AF, Channel 294D, Ripley, West Virginia (BLFT-20120618ABS). Vandalia herein requests authorization to relocate the W294AF facilities.

It is proposed to relocate the K216FD antenna to an existing tower that has been registered with the FCC and assigned Antenna Structure Registration Number 1289990. As this is an existing tower, no further action with regard to FCC registration or FAA notification is required.

The proposed W294AF facility will rebroadcast the signal of AM station WMOV, 1360 kHz, Ravenswood, West Virginia. The proposed W294AF 60 dBu contour does not extend past the WMOV 2.0 mV/m contour nor does it extend past 25 miles from the WMOV tower site. W294AF is considered a fill-in translator for WMOV. Exhibit A is a map demonstrating compliance with §74.1201(g) of the Commission's rules.

Exhibit B demonstrates there is common 60 dBu service area between the proposed W294AF and the W294AF license.

The worksheets associated with FCC Form 349 were used to demonstrate compliance with the Commission's human exposure guidelines for radio frequency radiation. All supporting data used in the preparation of this application has been forwarded to Vandalia and is available for submission to the Commission upon request.¹
