**MULTIPLE OWNERSHIP**  
**FAMILY LIFE MINISTRIES, INC.**  
**April, 2016**

Family Life Ministries, Inc. (“FLM”) is the licensee of non-commercial full power FM stations in New York and Pennsylvania. It is proposed to acquire full-power FM stations WCIS-FM (formerly WOLF-FM), Fac. ID 22134, DeRuyter, NY and WCIO(FM) (formerly WWLF-FM), Fac. ID 5344, Oswego, NY and that both of these presently licensed commercial stations would be proposed to be converted to non-commercial licenses.

During the pendency of the period for processing of the assignment applications until grant and consummation, the two above-referenced stations would continue to operate under authorization of their respective commercial licenses. In addition, the above-referenced stations and FLM’s FM station WNDR-FM (formerly WSEN-FM), Fac. ID 7716, Baldwinsville, NY are operating under cross Time Brokerage Agreements (“TBAs”) which have been previously filed and are included for reference within this application.

Also, FLM has recently consummated its transaction for the acquisition of FM station WCIT-FM (formerly WMCR-FM) Fac. ID 58038, Oneida, NY which has also been proposed for non-commercial operation (BMLH20160112AAP).

During the transition period and including the TBAs, FLM would temporarily hold four attributable interests within the Syracuse, NY radio market. According to BIA, the Syracuse market has 41 full power-power radio stations. In a radio market with between 30 and 44 full-power stations, an entity and any affiliated parties may have

cognizable interests in up to seven stations with no more than four in the same service. FLM would temporarily have a cognizable interest in four FM stations. After grant, discontinuance of the TBAs, consummation, and conversion to non-commercial status, the ownership limits imposed by Section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules would no longer apply with regard to FLM's radio station ownership within the market.
